Summer Season Weekly check-in time is **3:00 p.m.**

Summer Season Weekly check-out time is **9 a.m.**

The charge for late check-out is \$25.00 per hour or part.

Spring or Fall midweek and weekend check-in and check-out times are by prior arrangement.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the water safe to drink?

Yes! Tap water at Sunbeam Bungalows comes from the main Callander Drinking Water System, and meets the standards of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002.

Where can I shop for groceries?

Foodland, right here in Callander, is your closest food store. You'll find a Metro and a No Frills supermarket 10-15 minutes down the road in North Bay (Lakeshore Drive). Please see the "local businesses and services" list in this folder for more information on local businesses (e.g. restaurants). Also, see: www.mycallander.ca/business-directory/

Where can I get a fishing licence?

Fishing licences are available from us— just ask at the office. We also have live bait available for sale. Also at the office: an ice cream freezer with ice cream bars, cones, & popsicles available.

Where can I get firewood and ice?

For your convenience, we have bagged firewood for camp fires for sale at the office. We also have bagged ice for sale at the office.

Do I need a permit for a campfire in the fire bowl at my cottage?

No, there is no need for an individual permit. Please follow normal fire safety guidelines. If an official fire ban is issued due to extremely dry conditions, we will post a notice on the office notice board and let you know.

Do I need a boating licence for the rental boats?

No, you will require what's called a "boater's safety checklist" which is provided at no charge to you at our front office. It takes approximately 10-15 minutes to issue.

Do I need a boating licence for my own boat?

Yes. If you are a Canadian guest you must have a valid boating licence. If you are an American guest, and own your own boat, you are legally allowed in Canadian waters for no more than consecutive 45 days without having to obtain the licence.

Are alcoholic beverages permitted on the beach and deck?

You are permitted to have alcoholic beverages on the beach and deck, however NO open alcohol when crossing the road. Please consume responsibly, use receptacles for recycling (or collect up empty containers before leaving), and use non-breakable containers when possible, for safety reasons.

What are your policies/rules concerning dogs?

When outdoors, dogs are required to be leashed and picked up after at all times (Municipal By-Law 94-569). **Dogs are NOT permitted on the beach or marina deck.** If dogs are going with you on your boat, they may be taken directly to and from the boat, as long as they are on a leash. When indoors, please, no pets on the furniture; if this is unavoidable at certain times, a protective sheet or blanket must be placed on furniture. Your co-operation helps us provide a healthy and well-maintained place to stay.

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Is there a phone somewhere that I can use?

There's a pay phone beside the office (basketball net side) for local & long distance. If you need to contact us and we are not in the office, you may use the office phone to call: 705.493.1704

What equipment is available at the waterfront?

The kayaks, canoes, pedal boat, paddle board and all other beach items are available on a first come, first served basis. Please help yourself and don't forget to pick up a life jacket from inside our boat house. There are also kids' beach toys and flotation toys available in the boat house—please help yourself. Pumps provided if necessary.

What recreational equipment is available on the property?

On the games deck you will find a bin of basketballs; there is a small bin of toys at our play park area— please help yourself and return after use. The ping pong racquets and balls, as well as badminton racquets can be found in a bin under the ping pong table.

What TV channels do you get?

See the digital TV channel listings on the next page and on a laminated card on the TV stand. We also have a varied collection of over 400 **DVDs** you can borrow at no charge! Ask to see the list at the Office.



Are there any interesting facts you can tell me about the lake and its environs?

- Lake Nipissing is the 4th largest lake in Ontario, excluding the Great Lakes. It is about 65 km (40 miles) long and approximately 25 km (15.5 miles) wide. (Source: <http://www.nipissing.net/>)
- Callander Bay was a major logging waterway in the 1930's.
- Sunbeam Bungalows opened in the 1930's.
- The township of Callander originated in 1881, however the location was discovered and occupied many years earlier.
- Lake Nipissing has a surface area of 873.3 square kilometres (337.2 sq mi), and has an average depth of 4.5 metres (15 feet) , with its deepest known point being 52 metres (171 ft).
- There are over 40 species of fish in Lake Nipissing.
- During the boating season, the water level in Lake Nipissing may fluctuate up to half a metre (approximately 19 inches).
- When Lake Nipissing's water is lowered by 1 centimetre (a little less than 1/2 inch) in a day, the French River may rise as much as 48 centimetres (approximately 19 inches)!

Policies, Terms & Conditions

RESERVATIONS

- We require a \$400.00 deposit on any booking with a value of \$1,000 or higher, or a \$200 deposit on bookings with a value of less than \$1,000. Deposits require a valid VISA or MasterCard. Deposits may be made by VISA, MasterCard or e-transfer and should be payable to Sunbeam Bungalows. If you cannot be accommodated, the deposit will be refunded immediately in full.
- By sending us a deposit you are deemed to have accepted all Policies, Terms & Conditions of Sunbeam Bungalows Family & Fishing Resort. You do not have a reservation until your deposit has been received and the reservation is confirmed by us in writing, by email or postal service.
- Accommodations and equipment will be charged fully for the time period reserved; no allowance will be made for early departures or late arrivals.
- Rates do not include tax (13% HST) or gasoline.
- U.S. currency is accepted at prevailing bank rates and credited in full.
- The balance of your reservation is due upon arrival. We accept VISA, MasterCard, Discover, cash, e-transfer or debit card (Interac). We do not accept cheques. Additional items, such as bait, firewood, etc. are payable before departure.

CANCELLATIONS

- A \$50.00 administrative fee applies to all cancellations made up to 60 days prior to your arrival date. The remainder of your deposit will be returned.
- In the case of cancellations made 59-14 days before arrival date, your deposit is non-refundable.
- In the case of cancellations made less than 14 days before arrival date, the full amount of the reservation rate will be charged.
- No credit will be given if facilities offered or equipment arranged for are not used.

DAMAGE & LIABILITY

- Facilities offered at Sunbeam Bungalows are for the exclusive use of registered guests and are used at guests' own risk.
- We will not be held liable for any damages, injuries or losses incurred while on our premises or while using any of our equipment.
- Guests are fully responsible for all damages and losses to boats, motors, equipment and accommodations provided, however caused. Please note that broken, bent, or nicked propellers, skegs, or lower units etc., are not considered "normal wear & tear" and will be billed at repair or replacement cost. Please report damage or malfunctioning equipment immediately. Major damage to boats/motors will be quoted by a licensed marine mechanic and will require payment authorization on your credit card prior to check out. An invoice/receipt for work completed will be sent to you.
- We provide approved life jackets with all boats, which must be carried for each person. When you bring your own boat, this responsibility is yours.
- All boat rentals require a \$500.00 damage deposit hold, on VISA or MasterCard, to be authorized on arrival. Damage deposit hold will be released at check out if boat has not been damaged and is clean.

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PETS

- We do allow dogs at the resort, with conditions. These policies help ensure that having dogs at the resort is acceptable to everyone.
- One dog per cottage is allowed, unless management approves otherwise.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times while being walked.
- Dogs must not be left to roam (maximum 10 foot long lead when tied up).
- Continual, ongoing barking is not acceptable; owner is responsible for ensuring compliance.
- Dogs must not be left alone in cottage for extended periods of time. Leaving your dog alone will cease to be allowed if your dog is making noise or causing damage.
- Owners must clean up after dogs at all times.
- Dogs are not permitted on furniture.
- Dogs are not to be bathed in the cottage shower or bath tub. (Please consult us for alternatives we may be able to suggest.)
- Dogs are not allowed on the beach or in the marina area; the only exception is if on leash accompanying you to your boat.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- Weekly check-in time is 3:00 p.m.
- Weekly check-out time is 9 a.m.
- Check-in and check-out times for mid-week/weekend stays (Spring/Fall) are generally more flexible; adjustments may be made by prior arrangement with management.
- If you arrive early please be prepared to wait; however, if the cottage is available, you may be able to check-in earlier.
- We ask that you respect the check out time, so that housekeeping staff can clean and prepare cottages without delay. The charge for late check-out is \$25.00 per hour or part. A pre-arranged late check out may be possible with 24 hours advance notice - please consult management.
- We reserve the right to substitute accommodations and equipment should the need arise due to circumstances beyond our control.

VISITORS

- All visitors must register at the resort office.
- Daytime fee for visitors is \$10.00/day (any age).
- Overnight charges are as per rate chart. Visitors may stay overnight, provided the maximum occupancy for the cottage is not exceeded.

REGULATIONS

- NO SMOKING inside the cottages.
- No campfires in the event of a fire ban by MNR (Ministry of Natural Resources & Forestry). Fire ban notices are posted in the resort office.
- All municipal by-laws must be respected.
- For the comfort of all concerned, all quiet after 11pm.
